Let me now begin my report with school activities and programmes which integrate children of Pre-primary, Primary and Secondary sections.

The Academic year 2018-2019 began on June 7th, An orientation programme was arranged for the parents, to help them get acquainted with the philosophy of Litera education and the class routine. Our Kinder Garden Kids came back to school with lots of joy on June 14th.

TEACHERS INSERVICE TRAINING & WORKSHOPS

In keeping with the school's policy of continuous upgradation of knowledge and skills, our teachers attended various workshops and seminars organized by Zee Learn and other institutions.

On 26th, 27th and 28th, the Academic Manager of Zee Learn Mrs. Anuratha Premnath visited the School and inspected the learning process and trained our staff to enhance their language skill.

Our Regional School Director, Dr. Radha Krishnan conducted periodic training sessions for the teachers, which involves Child Handling, Moulding and scheduling academics.

An expert of Karadi path Team gave exclusive training for our staff members regarding the usage of Language and way of expressions. It was very informative for Language trainers.

The techniques learned in the trainings were implemented in the classroom by teachers.

PARENT – STUDENT COUNCELLING:

Mount Litera offers support and guidelines to its parents by conducting frequent counseling programmes on the topic "Effective Parenting". The first counseling session of this academic year was conducted on 22nd June 2018 for grade IX and X Parents. Eco Club:

In eco-club, students performs activities to save the environment, like planting trees, organizing poster competitions on various environmental issues.

Art and Craft Club:

Art and craft club in the school enhances child's individual's craftsmanship, giving them an exposure to various types of craft and art.

Musical, Dance & Drama Club:

In extracurricular activity hours students are provided training in dancing, singing and learning playing music in keyboard. The students are then provided opportunities to perform in School celebrations and inter school competitions.

Language and Expression Club:

The Language clubs give learners the opportunity to practice speaking and listening, improve employability and increase their vocabulary in an informal and friendly setting. On 17th November Karadi Path APP implementation workshop was conducted. The effectiveness of the methodology and app usage was effectively explained by the expert trainer.

Exhibition Club:
